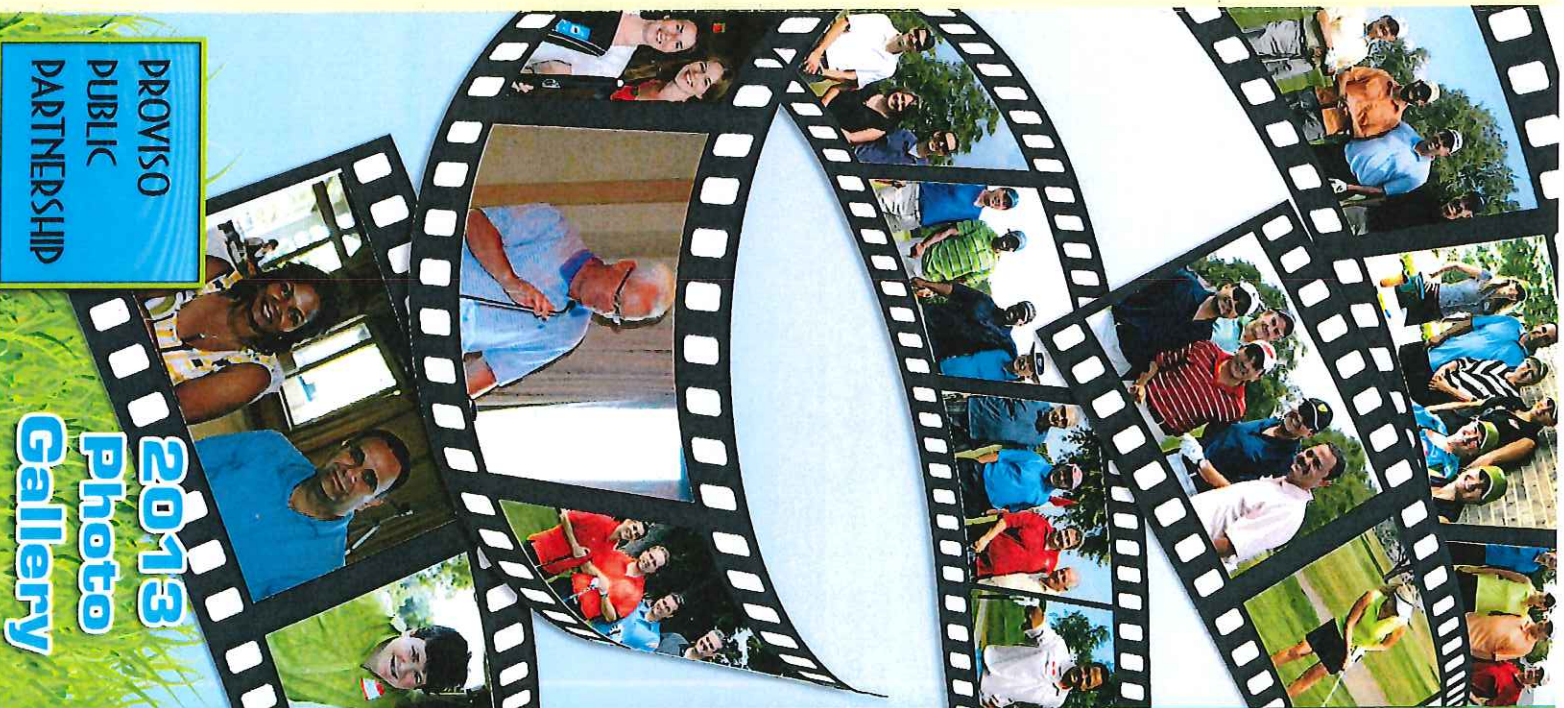

A letter from Jesse D. Rosas;

As the fiscal year 2013 draws to a close, the Proviso Public Partnership would like to send a special thank you for supporting our partnership efforts bringing together various organizations to better the lives of our most vulnerable populations. Together, we are helping to develop partnerships and programs that support, inform, and provide much needed services in Proviso Township. This year, we made headway in our quest to fill the gaps in services and to increase the availability of social service programs in Proviso Township. One example of our efforts was the development of the affordable housing program aimed at helping families with special needs and lower incomes find affordable housing in Proviso Township. Together with the Proviso Township Mental Health Commission, we have secured agreements with the Illinois Housing Development Authority to begin creating housing opportunities that will offer new homes to families that traditionally could not afford them. During the year we also worked in concert with local providers to create healthcare opportunities in the Township by partnering with 2 local providers to enroll families in healthcare. The Proviso Public Partnership, as the lead organization in our area, coordinated the movement. It provided In Person Counselors, and partnered with Libraries, Schools and other organizations to help us enroll over 2000 families in Proviso and neighboring villages in the Affordable Care Act. Another great opportunity was the partnership with a local business that is helping support social service programming in their area. Food 4 Less is helping families in Proviso by donating a percentage of purchases made at the Melrose Park Store to help support much needed programs in Proviso Township. As we look into the future we are continuing to develop joint ventures and create partnerships that bring together the best and brightest in our area to work towards a mutual goal.

We want to again thank you, our new partners, and the residents of Proviso Township for your support and efforts to improve the lives of our residents. We ask you to join us in our second annual golf outing to help fulfill our promise to make Proviso Township a model community for the future.
